## Bible Reading Schedule

### “Declaring a Victory”

**A** victory “shout” is an important part of any concluding process for believers. Technically, Jesus has already won the Victory by His defeat of Satan at Cavalry and the “spoil” of all principalities and powers following His resurrection (Col 2:15). For us, we wage the “good fight of faith” on a daily basis. By definition, faith means that you have the Victory now in Christ.

For instance, when Jesus told Peter, “Come”, Peter stepped out of the boat and began walking to Jesus on the water. Peter then began to observe the “wind and the waves” and he began to sink. This is a clear description of where faith begins and where it ends.

Peter was actually “walking” on Jesus’ Word, “Come”. Faith was there, and Jesus had the Victory standing out on the water. Peter also shared in the Victory and power until he became “double-minded”. Double-mindedness is described as a dual reference point. As long as Peter only “observed” Jesus and His Word, Peter shared in the Victory. However, when Peter took his eyes off Jesus and saw the storm, he began to sink.

So, stay “on the Word”, and declare the victory. It is yours because you have it by faith. As long as you are “on the Word”, you have the victory.
