Bible Reading Schedule

“The Prophetic Anointing”

To speak prophetically has a value. 1 Corinthians 12 shows us that prophecy is one of the gifts given to the body of Christ that helps the unsaved perceive God’s presence and involvement. People who don’t know Jesus are locked into a void that lacks spiritual perception. If they manage to engage something spiritual, it is misrepresented to them by the forces of darkness. An example of this is the occult.

But, as a bible reader and a Christian, you have a treasured relationship with the Holy Ghost. He is able to reveal spiritual things to you.

With this, God is able to use you as a mouthpiece to provide prophetic utterance.

This is also sometimes called “an inspired utterance”. Prophetic utterances fall into two categories, foretelling (predicting future events) and forth telling (declarative and informative).

Predicting the future certainly has value, but forth telling is more common. An example: forth telling is shown in Revelation 19:10, “...worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.”.

A testimony is about a past event. But by “testifying” about Jesus, you are glorifying Him, and God takes over your speaking. Doing this habitually brings a “prophetic anointing” into your life. In time, you’ll find yourself saying things to people prophetically. It’s as though you became a “silver-tongued orator”. You say things you don’t have knowledge of.

One of the biggest examples of this is Moses. Moses had a problem with speaking, but he obeyed God and God used him. The first five books of the Bible were written by Moses. We too can work under the prophetic anointing to deliver inspired utterances to others.
