Bible Reading Schedule

“Enemies Defeated”

Jesus defeated Satan and all the workers of darkness by His death, burial, and resurrection. Calvary is a finished work.

Our position is to enforce Satan’s defeat. Jesus said it like this, “occupy till I come” (*Luke 19:13*). We are an occupation force. So, as we advance the Kingdom through preaching the gospel, we are stealing ground once controlled by the Enemy.

The Bible type is Israel’s possessing of the Promised Land. It was theirs by **Promise**, but “every place on which your foot shall tread...” (*Joshua 1:3*) was how they would **possess it**....

In our lives, like theirs, we must root out a defeated foe and fully possess our freedom that has been granted us by Calvary.

“Occupy” means to “dwell” in the land. Jesus also used the word “Abide”. It means to take up residence. Healing is ours to abide in, not just experience a tour. Same with prosperity... It’s a lifestyle, not just a shopping trip.

Christians maintain the strength necessary to “Abide” by feeding on God’s Word. Don’t give up hard fought ground. “Be strong in the Lord and in the Powers of His Might.” (*Ephesians 6:10*).
