Bible Reading Schedule

“Healing”

When Jesus paid for our redemption, He paid the **Full Price**. Redemption means “To buy back”. So, when Jesus bought us back, He had to pay for our **healing** also.

Much like our financial lives, in order for us to be free from debilitating problems in this life, our redemption included both healing and financial freedom.

Jesus took “stripes” on His body to pay our account.

“Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. -Isaiah 53:4-5

“Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.”- 1 Peter 2:24

God accepted Jesus’ suffering as payment for us. “Substitutionary Sacrifice” is the phrase theologians use. “Vicarious Suffering” is another one. So, in the same way Jesus paid for our sins with His Blood, He paid for our healing with His Stripes. When we got saved, our faith was “cashing in” on what was “on account” for us.

Our faith received our forgiveness because of Jesus’ Blood. As a result, we were born again. When the Gospel is presented fully, our faith is able to receive our **full redemption**. Our physical Healing is part of our “Redemptive Package.”
